The crisis which erupted two days ago has been attributed to disagreements over the ownership of disputed farmlands by the warring communities.

< According to sources, the dispute led to the use of dangerous weapons culminating in the destruction of houses, farmlands and property worth millions of Naira.

At the moment, many who are mostly women and children, have been rendered homeless while some have taken refuge in nearby communities while the affected communities have been deserted.

Reacting to the incident, member of the State House of Assembly, representing Guma State Constituency, Mr. David Iorhemba, decried the outbreak of violence in his constituency.

The lawmaker pleaded with his people to toe the path of peace as fighting in the communities would create a state of insecurity in the area given its attendant consequences on the well-being of the people.
