Three die in *Okada* accidents

THREE persons weekend, lost their lives in separate road accidents in Lagos. In one of the incidents in the Festac area, report said a motorcyclist who was trying to avoid a pot hole, ran into an Opel Omega Salon car with registration number HK 709 EKY along 5th Avenue.

The motorcyclist whose identity could not be ascertained, died on the spot while his female passenger reportedly breathed her last before reaching the hospital.

A similar incident occurred along Iba/Igando road Sunday night, after a Toyota Corolla Saloon car with plate number JE 66 AAA driven by one Adeseun suddenly veered off its lane. In the process, the vehicle reportedly ran into an unknown male pedestrian at Omolade bus-stop, who unfortunately died before reaching the hospital.

Traffic policemen from the respective police divisions according to the Lagos State Police Public Relations Officer, Mr Frank Mba, visited the scenes and removed the corpses to the public mortuary.
