NDLEA officials arrested over suspected trafficker's death

KANO — POLICE in Kano have arrested two agents of National Drug Law Enforcement Agency over their role in the controversial death in cell of a notorious drug peddler, Aminu Umar.

The Police Public Relation Officer in Kano, Baba Muhammad told *Vanguard* that the men were undergoing interrogation to ascertain their culpability or otherwise on the controversial death of the late drug peddler.

The police image maker, who refused to disclosed the names of the officials, further

assured of the readiness of the Command to charge the two suspects to court as soon as it concludes investigations on the matter.

"Two NDLEA officials are under police custody. They are undergoing interrogation and we will charge them to court as soon as we conclude our investigations on the matter," the PPRO said.

Vanguard, however, learnt that the two NDLEA agents were reported to have set up a booby trap for the late Umar, who for long has been on the wanted list of the agency, and was subsequently arrested and taken to their head office for interrogation.
