

1 killed as gunmen rob Oando Petrol Station

LAGOS—BARELY 48 hours after suspected assassins murdered *The Guardian's* Assistant News Editor, Mr. Bayo Uhu, at his Egbeda residence, six suspected armed robbers yesterday evening robbed the

Oando Filling Station at Akowonjo roundabout, killing an unidentified man and reportedly carting away unspecified large sum of money.

Simultaneously, a storey building at 1, Bada Close, off Dopemu-Shasha roundabout, few metres from the robbery spot, was gutted by

fire suspected to have been caused by electrical sparks from a power generator.

According to witnesses, the robbers operating on three motorcycles stormed the station at 6.45 p.m and started shooting sporadically into the air to scare away people.
