5 die as vehicle somersaults in Lagos

IVE passengers in a Volkswagen commercial bus were, yesterday, burnt to death after the vehicle lost a tyre on motion and somersaulted at Oworonsoki. Lagos. The bus was on a routine shuttle from Lagos Island when one of its tyres burst. The driver immediately lost control as the vehicle began to somersault, trapping several of the passengers.

The lucky ones among them were able to escape, while five could not make it out. They were burnt beyond recognition. An

eye witness said one of the passengers that bailed out of the burning vehicle ran into another vehicle which knocked him down. He was rushed to the hospital. The accident caused a massive traffic jam on the Third Mainland bridge.
