according to source made away with all monies found in the banking hall after they succeeded in overpowering the bank security operatives, but lost their bearing on the track to escape out of the town before nemesis spooked on them while they were trying to intimidate some innocent village women who later raised alarm to show them the way out.

Two of the robbers the source also disclosed lost their lives as they got drowned in the Ikot Abasi river while they were chased by the men of the police force who came in the gun boat procured by the Akpabio administration to aid the police combat

crime in the state, while an indigene of the area suspected to be a member of the gang and who using his motorcycle to do surveillance while their operation lasted was also apprehended by youths in the Town, badly beaten up and handed over to the police.

An indigene of Ikot Abasi and a staff of the Aluminium Smelter Company, AC RUSAL, former Alscon, however commended the state police Commisioner for working round the clock to curb the incidences of crime especially throughout the festive period.
