

Gunmen kill JUTH doctor

JOS—UNKNOWN assailants, Wednesday, killed a medical doctor of the Jos University Teaching Hospital, JUTH, Dr. Osaretin Osagie, at his Rayfield residence in the Plateau State capital.

It was not immediately clear if they were armed robbers or assassins as details of the attack were still scanty at press time.

It was learnt that the at-

tackers invaded the compound around 7.30p.m. and that on hearing the movement, the late doctor came out to see what was happening.

The attackers were said to have pounced on him, hitting him with various objects until he became unconscious.

He was reported to be bleeding profusely and was rushed to hospital where his colleagues at JUTH battled to save his life until he died in the early hours of yesterday.
