Meantime, the late Pango was taken hostage at about 9.00 pm on Tuesday in Tai by some persons who allegedly shot sporadically to ward off any resistance. His lifeless body was later discovered

Some persons feared the death could be politically

motivated because the late Pango had allegedly indicated interest to contest for the Chairmanship seat of Gokana local government
