scene of the crash made women, who rushed to the scene from a nearby village, to weep uncontrollably, even as other passengers and motorists stopped and assisted in rescuing the victims.

The vehicle, belonging to Eastern
Gateway Mass Transit Limited, with
serial number 19, was said to have
conveyed passengers from their loading
point in **Enugu** at about 11am,
yesterday.

Although the cause of the accident was not immediately known, the eyewitness said the driver of the Toyota commuter bus may have lost control of the vehicle because of over-speeding.

The eyewitness said: "I personally watched one of the victims breath his last about six minutes after he was brought out from the wreckage of the bus which was also carrying some bags of flour. It was indeed a very fatal accident."

According to him, two separate teams of policemen on patrol arrived the scene at about 12noon shortly after the wounded and **dead** passengers were taken away to Bishop Shanahan Hospital, Nsukka.


