LAGOS—Dare-devil robbers yesterday stormed the Lagos residence of Dr. Orji Uzor Kalu, former governor of Abia State in Victoria Island and shot dead one of his workers, Michael Ogbonna. The robbers numbering two also carted away N2 million.

The incident happened at about 4 pm. The robbers were said to have trailed the deceased and two others, who had gone to the Adeola Odeku branch of Diamond Bank, to withdraw some money. An eye witness, Emenike said the three of them went to the bank at about 3.30 pm to withdraw some money and came back to meet strange faces at

When informed that the people affected went to report the matter at Bar Beach bus stop and were still there, Jinadu promised to contact the DPO) and get back to the reporter but he never did.









