

Robbery in Kalu's house: Police arrest two security guards

POLICE operatives have arrested two persons believed to have masterminded the robbery that took place at the Victoria Island, Lagos, residence of the former governor of Abia State, Dr. Orji Uzor Kalu. During the robbery, one of the domestic staff of Kalu, Michael Ogbonna, was shot dead by the robbers, who also carted away N2 million.

A police source at the Bar Beach police station, where the robbery incident is being investigated, said that two guards of the former governor are currently undergoing interrogation.

The police source disclosed that the suspects were picked by the police, after preliminary investigation showed that the duo have some questions to answer in respect of the robbery. "They are being interrogated and I am sure that after interrogation, we may not be wrong in our suspicion."

The police source, who does not want his name in print said it was the deceased and one of the arrested suspects, who came to the station and said they did not need police guards in the premises.

He said: "Before now, there were five policemen attached to the premises, because Orji Uzor Kalu is not an ordinary citizen, but when the domestic staff told the police that they no longer need their services, the police have no choice than to withdraw their personnel."
