

Naval officer kills girlfriend in Lagos

LAGOS — TRAGEDY struck, Saturday, at the Nigerian Navy Base, Ojo, Lagos State, when a Naval officer stabbed his girl friend to death.

The officer, identified simply as Harry, was said to have engaged his girl friend, Itoya, who also is a naval personnel, in a fight over claims of infidelity.

Vanguard gathered that the deceased officer who hails from Edo State, met her untimely death, when her boyfriend who had just returned from a Joint Task Force mission in Jos, Plateau State, attacked her in their apartment, while she was sleeping and stabbed her severally while he also stabbed himself. Neighbours who heard screams from the apartment rushed

in only to find Itoya lying in a pool of blood.

She was rushed to a naval hospital in the base, but she died on the way to the hospital.
