Asaba—A mother has reportedly killed her 12-year-old son, confessing that she was a member of a secret cult.

The incident took place at Effurun, Delta State. As a result of the action, the woman is currently being interrogated by the State Criminal Investigation Department, SCID, at the state police command's headquarters, Asaba.


