## Woman kills husband over baby food, pampers

LAGOS—TRAGEDY struck Saturday, at Ago-Okota area of Lagos State, when a middle-aged man, identified as Ifeanyi

Anaekwe, slumped and died during a scuffle with his wife in their apartment.

A police source who did not want to be identified, told *Vanguard* that "neighbours reported that the victim was first clubbed from behind early with a pestle and he slumped. She reportedly stabbed him several times.


"They claimed an argument ensued between the man and his wife when the wife requested for money to buy pampers and baby food for their newly baby.
