10 die in Ogun auto crash

ABEOKUTA – No fewer than 10 people died in a fatal accident, Monrday, along Lagos-Ibadan expressway, in Isara-Saapade, Remo North Local Government Area of Ogun State, while eight others were seriously injured.

The accident, according to an eyewitness, involved a Lagos-bound 18-passenger commercial bus with number plate Kebbi AA 189 AUG, coming from Kebbi State.

The eyewitness said the accident occurred when the bus rammed into a stationary articulated truck, popularly known as trailer, with number plate, Lagos XV 512 EKY, near Isara-Saapade.

Confirming the accident, Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Muyiwa Adejobi, said the Commissioner of Police, Mr. Nicholas Nkedeme, had visited the accident scene and confirmed the number of people that died on the spot.




