# Four feared dead as cult groups terrorise Calabar

CALABAR – RESIDENTS of Calabar, Cross River State capital, have been living in fear in the last three days as a result of the activities of two rival cult groups.

It was gathered that about four persons have been killed so far in cult related clashes, though the Police Public Relations Officer of the state command, Mr. Hogan Bassey, put the number at two, adding that the clashes were between suspected members of the Vikings and KK cult groups.

On Monday, a group suspected to be junior members of KK, which goes by the name Mafs, broke into the house of a journalist, Mr. Frank Inyang, an Assistant Director in the Ministry of Information, whose wife gave birth few weeks ago, destroyed all the home appliances and almost killed his brother,



He said that the group, numbering over 50, and armed with guns, axes, cutlasses and other dangerous weapons, took advantage of the black out in the area to attack unsuspecting residents and shot sporadically.
