in Zaria, according to natives of Kakeyi, had mounted a road block early in the morning and were allegedly robbing people when they met the Lebanese, Mr. Padi Ibrahim and killed him before abducting his colleague, Amir Drek. The gunmen also killed a Nigerian, one Mallam Aliyu Nuruddeen.

The two people killed and the one abducted worked for Mother Cat Construction Company and were said to be on their way to inspect the much-delayed Zaria Water Works rehabilitation project.

One of the eyewitnesses, who identified himself as Sani Ado of Kakeyi Village said: "They blocked the road

leading to the project site in the village and robbed passers-by before killing two people and kidnap-

ping an Arab.
"The victims were well known as workers here. When they saw the road block at the end of the bend, they made a sudden Uturn. But the armed robbers pursued them and shot two of them dead.

"One of the Arabs was forced into their car, and they escaped with him.'
