

# Five Feared Killed By Gunmen In Borno

**FIVE** people were killed on Thursday in Maiduguri metropolis of Borno State when gunmen attacked a residence and beer hotel about 1pm yesterday. The victims included a classroom teacher.

The killings, according to Police authorities, were carried out in three separate incidents at Abaganaram Market, Kofa Bivu area and a hotel in Gwange ward of Maiduguri.

Confirming the incidents yesterday in Maiduguri, spokesman of the Borno State Police Command, Gideon Jibrin, said: "There were attacks at the Abaganaram market and Kofa Bivu where two people were killed on Thursday afternoon, but the Police area commanders of the two affected areas, are yet to send their official reports on the killings to us.

"Also on the same day, that is on Thursday, a classroom teacher was shot dead before his wife and children in Sulemanti Ward of Maiduguri metropolis."

He said no arrests had been made in the two separate attacks. Residents near the Zuwa Da Wuri hotel in Gwange wards ran for dear lives, as the gunmen stormed the area.
