
# Police in Rivers kill three suspected kidnappers

"Among their escapades were the murder of Ambassador Ignatius Ajuru and his escort personnel. The gang also killed Mr. Hyacinth Nwangolo, former Rivers State Deputy Director and Head of Eco Service Department; murder of HRH Ben Nwaogu, traditional ruler of Nihi Etche; kidnap of five female National Youth Service Corps, NYSC, members in Eberi Omuma; kidnap of 120-year- old Pa Nwosu; kidnap of Mr. Kelechi in Eberi Omuma and numerous bullion van and bank robberies on Aba/Port Harcourt Expressway."

He said the robbery suspects were arrested at a Police checkpoint in Aluu area of the state, adding that the kidnap suspects were about abducting a man when they were arrested. He said the suspects were shot when they jumped from a Police patrol vehicle conveying them to their hideout to recover more weapons they allegedly used for their operations.

"Three of them were arrested by Aluu Special Police checkpoint in yet another attempt to kidnap a man in Aluu with their operational vehicle, a Honda CRV jeep," he said.


