WARRI—AN ex-militant commander, Selekeme Alade, was shot dead and a police officer wounded by a police patrol team on the hunt for fleeing armed robbers on Okoloba Road, Effurun, near Warri, on Wednesday evening.

Angry Ijaw youths besieged Ekpan Police Station, Ekpan, Thursday morning, in protest, and it took the combined efforts of

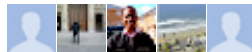

Selekeme, said to be an indigene of Ogiraigbene community in Bomadi Local Government Area, was reportedly returning from a restaurant where he went to buy food when the incident occurred.

Police Area Commander in Warri, Hussein Rabi, confirmed to Vanguard when contacted, yesterday, that there was an incident in which a policeman and one other person were shot, but the circumstance surrounding the shooting was ambiguous.

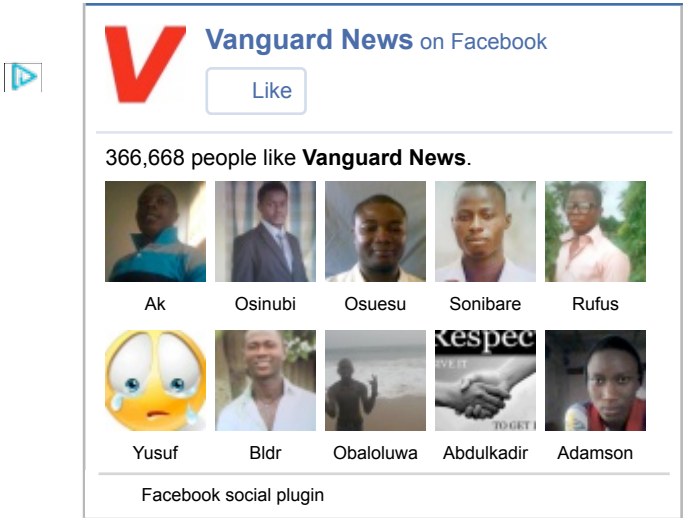

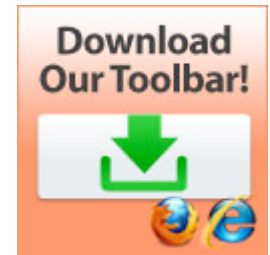
