

Two remanded over murder of Oba-elect's son

AKURE — TWO persons have been remanded in prison custody over the murder of the son of an Oba-elect, Orioye Oyetakin, in Ode-Etikan, Ilaje Local Government Area of the Ondo State.

Those remanded in prison

by an Akure Chief Magistrate Court are Ajoye Akin Ikuesan, 69 and Oroyo Omosehin, 43.

They were charged with a four-count charge which include murder, wounding and possession of dangerous weapons.

When the case came up, yesterday, before Chief Magistrate Rabi Adagunodo,

the plea of the accused could not be taken.

Police Prosecutor Isa Atenegbe, however, prayed the court to remand the suspects in prison custody for the advice of the Director of Public Prosecution (DPP).

The case was, however, adjourned till May 14, 2013 for further directive.
