IMT students beat security man to death

Nigeria (Enugu) A security staff of Institute of Management of Science and Technology, IMT, Enugu State, identified as Mr. Festus Ugwu, has been allegedly beaten to death by some students, who disagreed during a departmental election.

Ugwu and some security staff assigned to maintain law and order in the school during the student's election, were reportedly attacked by some students while intervening in the disagreement among the students.

Sources said the security man, who was seriously beaten up, sustained injuries on the head prompting the school authorities to rush him to the Memfy's Hospital Trans Ekulu Enugu but was confirmed dead by doctors on duty before any help could come his way. Confirming the incident, the state Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Ebere Amaraizu, said the state police command had commenced a full scale investigations into the unfortunate incident that occurred at 2.08 pm Tuesday.

He said that the corpse of deceased security man had been deposited at the Ntasiobi Specialist Hospital mortuary for autopsy.
