One dies, 9 injured in Ogun auto crash

A **B** **E** **O** **K** **U** **T** **A** — ONE person died while nine others were critically injured in a lone accident which occurred at Itori village in Ewekoro Local Government Area of Ogun State on the Abeokuta - Lagos expressway over weekend.

The Itori Unit Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission, FRSC, Fatai Bakare confirmed the accident, adding that the auto crash involved a passenger bus with registration number LAGOS, MUS 418 XE.

According to Bakare, the driver of the bus lost control when he suddenly ran into bad portion of the road, and crashed into the bush.

He said the passenger bus contained 10 occupants which comprised three males and seven females.

The Itori Unit Commander, however, said that one of the female victims, who was rushed to the hospital by officials of FRSC along with other occupants later died while the nine others were on danger list.
