Boko Haram kills three grand children, five others

NO fewer than eight Christians have been killed including three grand children in Gworza Local Government of Borno State by persons suspected to be operatives of Boko Haram. The victims were identified as Haruna Hurgwa, Ali Nigha Mbiya, Zakariya Ghirita, Tanko Zuwara, Yohanna Bulus and three grand children of one Andrew Felaku, all of

Gwoza Local Government Area of Borno State. A report said the Islamist group also burnt four churches in Juba village. The source told our reporter that the sect members, which entered the village at about 8;30 p.m., also burnt down the house of a member of the House of Representatives, Hon. Peter Biye, and one Catholic Church, Juba.
