

## Group calls on police to unmask killer-herdsmen

**W**ARRI—FORUM for Justice and Human Rights Defence, FJHD, Delta State, has called on the police to uncover the Fulani herdsmen who allegedly killed two farmers in their farms in Enhwe community, Isoko South Local Government Area of the state.

The herdsmen fled after killing 70-year-old Akpojotor Ogor and 55-year-old Andrew Edeki, both indigenes of Enhwe following a disagreement over damage caused by their cattle.

*Vanguard* gathered that the remains of the deceased persons were deposited by the police at an undisclosed hospital in Oleh.

Speaking on the matter, yesterday, national Coordinator of FJHD, Mr. Oghenejabor Ikimi, said "We condemn as barbaric, satanic and despicable, the recent killing of Mr. Ogor, a farmer, aged 70 and an indigene of Enhwe town and Mr Edeki, a farmer, aged 55 and also an indigene of Enhwe town at their respective farms in Enhwe by rampaging Fulani herdsmen.
