Police arrest quack doctor 5 yrs after conducting abortion

IBADAN — FIVE years after conducting an abortion on a woman, the Oyo State Police Command has arrested one Koye Babalola, 45, charged with the offence. The victim was said to have died in the process.

Confirming the arrest of the suspect, the state Police Public Relations Officer, PPRO, Deputy Superintendent of Police Olabisi Ilobanafor, said the suspect is currently helping the police in their investigation.

According to her, the suspect, before his arrest, was operating two illegal hospitals.

She gave the names of the hospital as Divine Hospital, Soka area along Sanyo and Gbemisola Memorial Hospital at Boluwaji area, Ibadan.

Ilobanafor noted that in September 2009, the suspect carried out operation on a pregnant woman.

In another development, three suspects have been arrested for alleged rape and robbery.

The PPRO gave their names as Aderibigbe Gbenga, Akinola Kazeem and Adeolu Emmanuel.

Items found with the suspects include Nokia handset valued at N18,500, crayfish valued at N3,000 and plantain chips valued at N200.

According to her, the suspects had driven the victim to a dilapidated building where she was robbed and raped.
