Three persons shot during last Thursday's invasion of Ibrede community in Ndokwa East Local Government Area, Delta State, Mr Favour Ogbere, is dead.

Ogbere, shot on the

waist, died on Monday evening at a private hospital in Ughelli, where he was rushed to for medical attention as a result of injuries he sustained, three days after the incident.
