Gunmen kill security man in Jos

Jos-TWO gunmen, night, invaded the permanent site of Jos University Teaching Hospital, JUTH at Lamingo, Jos, Plateau State, and shot two private security guards.

The state police command confirmed that one of the guards lost his life in the incident as he tried to stop the gun men's vehicle from forcing its way through the rear gate of the hospital.

According to a staff of the hospital who did not want his name in print, "the security man was shot when he discovered that there were arms in the car boot and was trying to stop the men from entering the hospital.

"The security man died during treatment in the hospital. The gunmen all escaped and their mission was not known. Security agents have been on alert after the incident."
