A DETECTIVES
from Ondo State Police
Command have launched
a manhunt for the killers
of a farmer identified as
Babangida Oni, who was
reportedly hacked to
death in his house at IseAkoko area of the state.

His murder threw the entire Fulani camp at Ise-Akoko in Akoko North-East Local Government Area of the state into mourning.

A source within the village said the farmers were planning to conduct a private investigation into the murder of their colleague, whose lifeless body was reportedly discovered by another farmer who visited his house in the morning of the incident.

He said police detectives were informed that three men invaded the camp in the early hours of the day Babangida was hacked to death and that police had launched a manhunt for the suspects.
