"A boy in the boat was bailing water from the boat and the calabash with which he was doing that fell from his hand and in the process of trying to retrieve it the boat capsized," the source who sought anonymity said.

## Man, 72, docked for defiling 11-year-old girl

BENIN CITY—THE Edo State Police Command, yesterday, arraigned a 72-year-old man, Mr. Solomon Ugiagbe, before the Egor Magistrate's Court, in Benin, for allegedly defiling an 11-year-old girl.

Ugiagbe, was arraigned on a one-count charge bordering on unlawful carnal knowledge. Vanguard learned that the accused person, said to be a grandfather, committed the offence on November 13, 2014, at 72, Okungbowa Street, in Egor Local Council of the state.

The matter was reported at the State Criminal Investigation Department, in Benin City.

The offence, according to the police prosecutor, contravened Section 218 of the Criminal

Code, Cap 48 Vol. II, Laws of the defunct Bendel State, Nigeria 1976, as applicable, Edo State.

However, the accuse person pleaded not guilty a urged the court to grants bail. The preside magistrate, Will Aziegbemhin, granted bail in the sum of N51 and adjourned the coctober 5, 2015.
