Report said the incident happened barely one hour after a woman who had gone shopping in the market was hit by a vehicle.

Eye witnesses blamed both accidents on the deceased's refusal to use the pedestrian

bridge at the bus-stop.

A similar incident involving a year and three-month-old baby also occurred same day at PPL bus stop, along Lagos-Badagry expressway.

Report said the baby and her four-year-old brother were on the verge of crossing the ever busy expressway without an adult guide, when an SUV hit them. But the impact on the baby was said to be more, as the tyres reportedly smashed her skull, while her brother was slightly hit in the leg.

Narrating how the accident happened, eyewitnesses who spoke to Vanguard on condition of anonymity, claimed that the children who strayed from their mother's shop, suddenly ran onto the expressway, without watching.
