Wada said: “These deaths are a big loss to all of us, God Almighty is the giver and taker of life. When we lose our people we should not ascribe blame to any factor, but accept it as the will of God Almighty.”

Wada, who promised that the state government would look into the welfare of the families of the deceased, also assured the community that he would provide it a clinic and portable water.

Spokesperson of the community, ASP Collins Omale (retd.), eulogised the governor for the visits which he described as

unique, noting that it was the first time in the history of the village that a governor was visiting them.
