Reports said that some minutes before 9 am on that fateful Tuesday, a female suicide bomber blew up herself and in the process also injured about 32 persons apart from the dead. El-Rufa'i who visited the scene later described the attack as a "terrible act of infamy," Earlier on June 7, two suspected members of the Boko Haram group were said to have escaped arrest during a gun battle with a team of joint security operatives at Ungwan Keke-B village of Chikun local government area. One of the security operatives was reported killed during the incident. According to a resident of the area, "we never knew that they are Boko Haram people. We just sighted a team of military personnel cordon the house, and then gun shots filled the air at about 11:56 p.m. which led to their escape and the killing of one soldier after several hours of

NAF jet crashes in Kaduna Seven persons were feared killed on August 29 when a Nigerian Air Force) chopper, a Dornier jet 228, crashed at the Ribadu Cantonment located at the old site of the Nigerian Defence Academy in Kaduna at about 6.30 am. Reports indicated that an unspecified number of residents sustained varying degrees of injuries when the aircraft crashed near two buildings at the cantonment. The ill-fated aircraft was said to be on its way to Abuja from the Kaduna Air Force Base.

Kaduna APC suspends Shehu Sani
