Herdsmen, farmers clash in Adamawa

YOLA—NO fewer than eight persons were feared killed and several others injured, following a clash between Koh community and herdsmen in Girei Local Government Area of Adamawa State.

This came barely a week after a similar incident claimed the lives of the three police officers sent on a surveillance mission to the community.

The first attack, which occurred in January, claimed the lives of over 40 persons, including a Divisional Police Officer in charge of Vinikland.

An eyewitness said the latest attack began when a Fulani herdsman trespassed into a farm in the community.

However, Police Public Relation Officer in the state, DSP Abubakar Othman, said only one person was killed.
