

Masquerade follower stabs another dead, docked

AN Iyaganku Chief Magistrate's Court, Ibadan, yesterday, remanded a 21-year-old member of a masquerade group, Ibrahim Agboluaje, in prison for allegedly stabbing a man to death.

Agboluaje of Ajegede area of Ibadan was arraigned on a two-count charge of conspiracy and murder.

The prosecutor, Sergeant Sunday Ojeleye, told the court that Agboluaje and others now at large committed the offences last week Monday at Ode-Aje Oloolu, Ajegede area of Ibadan.

Ojeleye said that Agboluaje allegedly caused the death of one Tunde Rasheed, 25, by stabbing him in the neck with a broken bottle.

He said that the stabbing and death of the deceased followed a fight that ensued among the followers of the popular Ibadan masquerade.

Adebisi adjourned the case till September 1 for mention.
