Dokubo Asari's wife dies in car accident

ALHAJA Zainab Asari Dokubo, the first wife of Alhaji Dokubo Asari, is dead. She died alongside a friend in a motor accident on her way to Ibadan.

Alhaji Ishaq Kunle Sanni, Chairman, Oyo State Muslim community, confirmed the death. He recalled that Zainab, who lived in Ibadan, had to relocate to Yenagoa, capital of Bayelsa State, when she was appointed Secretary of the Muslims Pilgrims Board.

He said: "Even then, there was hardly any month she was not in Ibadan for one Islamic programme or the other. She was a member of many Islamic organisations in Ibadan, including Oluyole Muslim community, under the leadership of Imam Mudashir Bada.

"She is survived by four children: Amirah, Hassan, Hussain and Osama.

"May Allah accept her multifarious and multidimensional jihad as acts of Ibadah and admit her to jannat Firdaous."
