# 'We didn't set out to kidnap Mrs Emefiele'

A member of the kidnap gang that abducted the wife of the Governor of the Central Bank of Nigeria, CBN, Margaret Emefiele, and three others, last Friday, has disclosed that the gang had no inkling of who their victim was.

The suspect, Musa Muhammad, and five others, who are Fulani and are currently being interrogated at the Edo State Police Command, were said to have confessed that they were simply on a random kidnapping operation on B e n i n - A g b o r Expressway, when they accosted Mrs. Emefiele's convoy.

### APC chieftain, 3 others assassinated in

PORT HARCOURT— GUNMEN have killed a chieftain of All Progressives Congress, APC, Mr. Boris Neenwi, who is from Yeghe community, Gokana Local Government Area of Rivers State.

The assailants also killed three others, who are yet to be identified at press time.



A source, (names withheld) said Neenwi was killed alongside the others, including a lady, at a junction in Nonwa community, Tai Local Government Area of the state.

The source narrated that Neenwi was standing at a junction in Nonwa, waiting for a commercial vehicle to travel in back to Port Harcourt, when, suddenly, armed men stopped in front of him and opened fire on him.

The source, who said that Neenwi was a former councillor that represented Yeghe community at the Gokana Legislative Assembly, added that bullets from the bandits hit the other three persons, who also lost their lives.

The source added that Neenwi had recently returned from a law programme in Maiduguri, Borno State, and complained of threats to his life from some

people based on his post on the social media.

Meanwhile, Rivers State Police Command said it was aware of the killings, but that the details were still sketchy.

The Police Public Relations Officer of the command, Mr. Nnamdi Omoni, said: "I am aware of the incident. I don't have the details of what happened now. I will respond fully when I get details."
