Jilted man kills 2 lovers with petrol bomb in Lagos

51-year-old businessman, Ayobami Oyedutan, and his lover were reportedly killed with petrol bomb by an enraged exlover of the woman, Sunday, at the woman's beer parlour at Americana Street, Jankara, Agbado-Ijaiye, Lagos State.

The woman, simply identified as Mama Corner, reportedly died on the spot, while her lover died on Monday at Gbagada General Hospital, following severe burns.

Sources said the suspect, simply identified as Old Soldier, sprayed the lovers with petrol and set them alight, while they were enjoying pepper soup and drinks inside the beer parlour.

The source said: "The ex-lover of the woman, who was not happy over her unfaithfulness to him, became angry and went

to the beer parlour, sprayed the man and woman with petrol and lit them up.

"The man, who lit the fire, got his cloth burnt as he was running out. The woman died in the beer parlour, while the lover died on Monday at Gbagada General Hospital."

Witnesses say the victims were trapped on the plastic chair, which worsened the situation before neighbours put off the fire.

It was further gathered that the deceased man was buried on Tuesday at his house in Ajasa village, Command area of Ipaja, Lagos.

It was learned that the trio involved in the fatal love saga were married to different

spouses.

The wife of the deceased man, Mrs Tolu Oyedutan, described the death as a "painful loss."

She told sympathisers that she was with her late husband until he gave up the ghost at about 11p.m. on Monday.

"My regret now is that my five-year-old son won't live to see his father when he grows up," NAN quoted the bereaved wife as telling mourners.

The police spokesperson in Dolapo ASP Lagos, Bhadmus, said that the command was yet to be officially informed of the incident as at press time.
