THERE is tension in Iguomo and Ikhuenbo communities in Uhumwonde Local Government Area of Edo state following the alleged killing of two persons in a communal clash involving the two communities.

The two victims whose names were given as Osamudiamen Erhumwunse and Solomon Osayi were from Iguomo. Six other victims, including a policeman sustained bullet wounds.

It was said that the decomposing bodies of the two victims were recovered on Thursday from a river in the community.

It would be recalled that both communities have been at war with each other over boundary dispute since 1976. Vice Chairman of Iguomo community, Stanley
