

Rivers' politician's guard, uncle assassinated

PORT HARCOURT—
UNKNOWN gunmen reportedly killed two persons, John Barine and Goodluck Didi, in Tai Local Government Area of Rivers State, Monday night.

One Hycent Ana, who confirmed the development to *Vanguard*, said the gunmen ambushed the duo within the community and shot them dead.

Ana disclosed that Didi was a gate-keeper to a politician and Barine is an uncle to the said politician in the area.

Ana explained that the victims had gone out of the compound to investigate a noise behind the fence, when they were shot dead by the assassins.

He said: "The development is tragic. The people of the area are now living in fear. On Monday night, assassins visited the home of one politician in Tai and killed his gateman and one of his uncles.

"The two of them were killed on the same spot. It is painful."

Meanwhile, the Public Relations Officer of the Rivers State Police Command, DSP Nnamdi Omoni, said he is not aware of the incident, but promised to reach the District Police Officer, DPO, in Tai for details.
