## ...kill one, injure another

Timde, popularly known as Baba Ope, and also attacked a lotto operator identified as Atiku, at ijanikin community in Ojo area of Badagry, Lagos.

It was learned that after the cultists shot Tunde, they also inflicted several machete and axe cuts on him at a lotto (*Baba Ijebu*) shop around Marin Street, behind Alapere Government Secondary School.

After attacking the first victim, they went for the second victim, Atiku, in front of an old abandoned building opposite a church where suspected hoodlums usually converge.

Luckily for *Atiku*, his family members who were around quickly rushed him to a private hospital, where doctors are battling to save his life.

It was gathered that the cultists trailed Tunde from Iyanera Bus Stop, where he worked as a toll collector for National Union of Road Transport Workers (Agbero), to the lotto shop where he was killed.

Tunde, an indigene of Abeokuta, Ogun State, his wife and two kids lived at 28 Alafia Street, opposite Alapere Government Secondary School, before they parked to their new abode in Ile-Oba area opposite of Otto Awori Local Council Development Area on Friday, two days before he was killed.

Contracted, spokesperson of Lagos State Police Command, CSP Chike Oti, said: "From records available to me, only one person died. The incident involved two people that were playing Baba Ijebu.

"They had some disagreements, which led to a fight, leaving both of them injured. Before help came, one of them passed on, while the other is responding to treatment."
