## Ondo varsity lecturer dies in fire incident

NDO State University of Science and Technology, OSUSTECH, Okitipupa, was thrown into mourning, yesterday, following the death of Professor Adegboyega Obadofin, allegedly killed by fire in his residence.

Professor Sunday Oginduyile, Vice Chancellor of the OSUSTECH, disclosed in Okitipupa that the university authorities had reported the matter to the Police to ascertain the cause of the fire.

Oginduyile said the fire reportedly happened about 1a.m.,

yesterday, at his residence in

Ayeka area of Okitipupa.

He said neighbours confirmed to him that there was neither public power supply nor was his power generating set on, when the incident occurred.

Obadofin, 65, was the Acting Dean, Faculty of Agricultural Sciences of

the university.

His words: "I was in great shock when I visited the late don's home. His death is a great loss, not only to his faculty but to the entire institution management, lecturers, cu students, workers and everyone un will greatly miss him."

He described the deceased, co whose family resides in Lagos, as a friendly person, a in gentleman and a hardworking Ri person, whose vacuum would be O difficult to fill.

It was gathered that his body 'm has been deposited at the State pa Specialist Hospital morgue in Okitipupa.
