Boko Haram attacks Borno communities

SUSPECTED Boko Haram insurgents on Saturday night attacked Mairari and Femari communities in Konduga Local Government Area of Borno State.

It was gathered that the insurgents attacked the communities at about 8:30 p.m; killed one person, set houses ablaze and carted away food items.

The attack came barely 12 hours after the insurgents killed more than 10 farmers and abducted others at Kuwa-Yangeya village on Maiduguri-Damboa Road on Saturday.

An eyewitness, Goni Umar, said the insurgents attacked the communities with gun trucks and motorcycles, carting away food items from shops and houses before setting them ablaze.
