

2 die, cars vandalised as hoodlums clash in Surulere

TWO persons were, yesterday, killed and several others injured when hoodlums in Adetola and Pako streets in Surulere Local Government Area of Lagos State clashed over disagreement on sports and other sundry issues. *Vanguard* gathered that the clash that later spread to other adjoining streets led to the vandalism of cars and destruction of other property worth millions of naira.

Other streets, where the residents also suffered injuries during the clash that lasted for hours, were Enitan, Adefowope and Willy Omiyi in Coker Aguda Local Council Development Area, LCDA in Surulere.

A resident, who spoke under anonymity, told *Vanguard* that they were able to prevent some property from been vandalised by the hoodlums, who brandished different weapons, before the law enforcement agencies arrived.

He noted that the arrival of police and detachment of military personnel further prevented the fracas from spreading to other adjoining streets.
