One dead, another injured in Lagos-Ibadan Expressway accident

GUN Command of Federal Road Safety Corps, FRSC, yesterday, said one person died, while one other sustained injuries in an accident which involved two vehicles along Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

Mr. Clement Oladele, Ogun Sector Commander of FRSC, disclosed this in Ota, Ogun State, saying the incident happened at about 6.30p. m on Saturday.

Oladele explained that the accident involved a Toyota SUV with number plates LSD 37 BR and a trailer with no number plate.

The sector commander said the Toyota lost control due to speeding and rammed into the trailer at Isara-Sapade, on Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

"The corpse has been deposited in the mortuary at Olabisi Onabanjo Teaching Hospital, Sagamu, Ogun State, while the injured is receiving treatment at the hospital, "he said.

He advised motorists to be cautious, obey traffic regulations and refrain from driving against traffic, to avoid unnecessary loss of lives.

The Sector Commander also admonished motorists to maintain the stipulated 50km per hour maximum speed limit within construction zones and refrain from overtaking till they are clearly out of the construction zones, as violators were liable to be prosecuted.
