The recent killing of a young graduate of Electronic Engineering, Prince Nnabuike Eze 1321 at Ohom, Unadu community in Igboeze South local government area of Enugu state has raised tension in the area as police were unable to unravel the circumstances surrounding the suspected killing of the young graduate. Nnabuike was brutally assailed to death with knives and broken bottles on June 2, 2019 by a group of cultists in the community.

The deceased, Prince Eze, was allegedly hacked to death by a group of cultists that

have been terrorising the community, robbing young girls and women with reckless abandon and robbing people of their valuables. The cultists were also said to be involved in attacking unsuspecting members of the community in broad day light, publicly smoking Indian hemp in markets in the community without any daring to question their atrocious acts.
