One Chance robbers kill AIT staff in Abuja

A staff of African Independent Television, AIT, Abayomi Adigun, has been killed by suspected *one chance* (robbers that pose as drivers and passengers) robbers in Abuja.

Adigun, who was said to have been recently transferred from Ilorin to Abuja to join the *Kakaaki* crew, was said to have been stabbed to death on September 1.

It was gathered that he took a cab on his way to work on Sunday night from Kubwa, a satellite town to Aya, where he would have joined a Keke Napep to his office, but fell into the hands of robbers that posed as cab operators.

His lifeless body was said to have been found by the Police on Tuesday along Kubwa Expressway with several stab wounds on his body.

Unconfirmed sources said some

of his organs were removed.

Consequently, the FCT Police Command, yesterday, said it had commenced investigation into the suspected stabbing to death of Adigun.

Police Public Relations Officer of the Command, Anjuguri Manzah, disclosed that allegations that the staff was killed by 'One Chance' robbers on Sunday night was being looked into by detectives.
