Gunmen kill 5 in Taraba

JALINGO—FIVE persons have been reportedly killed by qunmen in three different attacks, on Tuesday, in Wukari Local Government Area of Taraba State.

The Council Chairman, Daniel Grace, who spoke to Vanguard, said six other persons also sustained injuries.

Grace said: "The first attack was in Numa, where two people were killed in their farms and two others injured.

"In Yoyina, a vehicle was ambushed, which resulted in the death of two persons, while two others were injured.

Toshan, where another vehicle was also attacked and one person shot dead, while two others were injured."

Contacted, spokesman of Taraba State Police command, DSP David Misal, said the Police could only confirm the death of three persons from two separate attacks.

Misal said: "One person was killed when a bus coming from the East was attacked, while two other persons were killed in their farms."
