2 Otuoke varsity students killed

YENAGOA—THERE is palpable fear among the students of Federal University, Otuoke, Ogbia Local Government Area of Bayelsa State and indigenes of the area over the killing of two undergraduates by unknown persons.

One of the victims was identified as Edwin Eze, a 100 Level student of the Mathematics Education

Department.

He was found dead on Tuesday with multiple machete cuts and dumped along a street close to his hostel of residence.

The other victim, Chimzi Lloyd, was found dead in a bush with a gunshot wound to the chest.

It was gathered yesterday that a close friend to Tochi, known as Sammy Majestic, had declared him missing on Monday.

Sammy said: "We were together in the evening, when he ran out of the house and did not come back. We were very worried and contacted his friends and family. We even called his phone but it was switched off."

The corpse was later discovered close to his residence on Tuesday.

According to the community source, the killings are not unrelated to the silent cult war going on in the area.

The case has been transferred to the Criminal Investigation Department of the State Police Command in Yenagoa.

Contacted, Vice Chancellor, Professor Seth Jaja, said he was in Abuja on official duty and referred *Vanguard* to his deputy.
