

Boko Haram kill 11

Meanwhile, 11 hunters were killed by *Boko Haram* fighters in a Song Local Government Area of Adamawa State.

The Administrative Secretary of the state chapter of the Nigeria Hunters Association of Nigeria said 11 of its members were shot, while 13 sustained life-threatening injuries.

This is just as the state Police Command gave the casualty figure of the slain hunters as six.

The association's boss said: "What happened to my members between Gombi and Song was that 11 of them were invited by a member to assist him to control ravaging herders that took over his farmland. But unknown to him, the insurgents *Boko Haram* had laid siege on the area and they ran into them.

"The *Boko Haram* fighters, who rode on camels, used AK-47 to kill our members."

Adamawa Police Command spokesman, Suleiman Nguroje, had earlier confirmed the killing of the hunters but said only six were gun down by the insurgents.
